



Bookstack - Enable Single Sign On


To enable Bookstack SSO using Azure AD, you first need to have a local Bookstack account created. Log into bookstack using your 'local' bookstack credentials (non-ssso). Click on your name in the top-right and select "Edit Profile"



Scroll down to the bottom and Hit "connect account" under the "social accounts" section.

Social Accounts

Here you can connect your other accounts for quicker and easier login. Disconnecting an account here does not revoke previously authorized access. Revoke access from your profile settings on the connected social account.



You'll be redirected to O365 where you can log in using your email credentials. If you have MFA enabled, *(and you should- ask help desk for more information)* you'll be prompted to enter your code.


Verify

The first time you log in, you'll be asked if you'd like to allow the app "bookstack" to be trusted. You do.


Now log out of Bookstack and log back in using SSO. All done!
