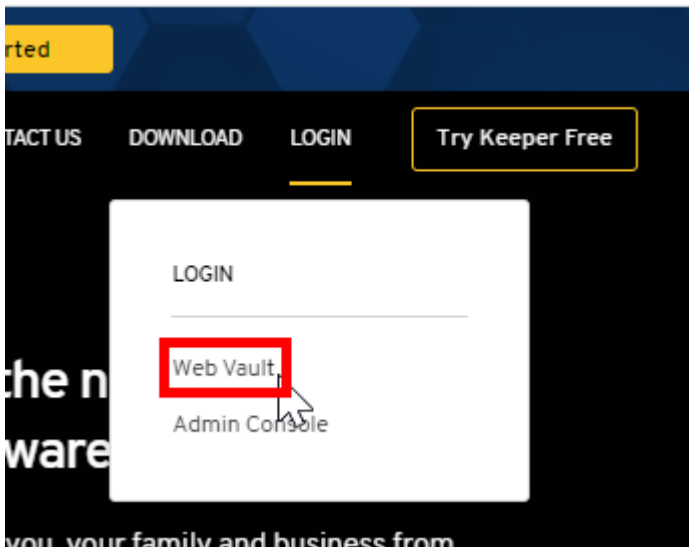


Keeper Security Logon

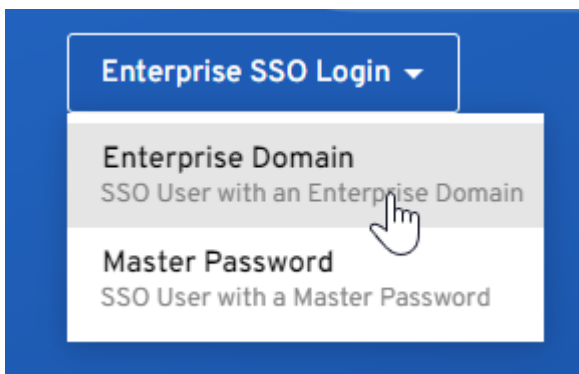
The Keeper Security logon process will use the Enterprise SSO option for work accounts.

Personal accounts on the family plan will use a "Master Password", which is not tied to any work account.

Navigate to the Keeper Security homepage (<https://keepersecurity.com>) and choose the web vault.



Choose "Enterprise SSO Login" and select "Enterprise Domain"




Personal accounts on the family plan will use email address and Master Password.

All Others = folience.com


